


# Giving To God's Church: We need your help!

# Today's Readings

## 2 Timothy 2.8-15

8 Remember Jesus Christ, raised from the dead, a descendant of David—that is my gospel, 9for which I suffer hardship, even to the point of being chained like a criminal. But the word of God is not chained. <sup>10</sup>Therefore I endure everything for the sake of the elect, so that they may

#### Luke 17.11-19

11 On the way to Jerusalem Jesus was going through the region between Samaria and Galilee. 12As he entered a village, ten lepers approached him. Keeping their distance, 13they

> called out, saying, 'Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!' 14When s a w hе them, he said t o them, 'Go and show yourselves the priests.' And a s they went, they were made

clean. <sup>15</sup>Then one of them, when he saw that he was healed, turned back, praising God with a loud voice. <sup>16</sup>He prostrated himself at Jesus' feet and thanked him. And he was a Samaritan. <sup>17</sup>Then Jesus asked. 'Were not ten made clean? But the other nine, where are they? <sup>18</sup>Was none of them found to return and give praise to except this God foreigner?' 19Then he said to him, 'Get up and go on your way; your faith has made you well.
